The Public Hearing on the Preliminary Budget opened with the reading of public notice by the clerk.

Michael Kolczynski spoke in regards to upcoming year's reserve. He further inquired about the accounts that increased more than 20%; explanations were given noting that a lot of the increases were due to the rising cost of fuel, and the one time projects for the township such as zoning and planning.

Discussions were held regarding the uncertainty of the federal/state revenues – such as sales tax, and CHIPS funding.

The budget to be adopted at the regular Town Board meeting scheduled for November 10th, 2008.
